

Bluebonnet Baptist Association 166th Annual Meeting Minutes October 14, 2024

The annual meeting was held at the campus of Oakwood Church, New Braunfels, TX.

Moderator, John Minton, Pastor of Everyday Christian Fellowship Church, Cibolo, called the meeting to order, welcomed everyone, and presented a motion to accept the Order of Business as printed in the 2024 BBA program. A motion was seconded to accept and adopt the Order of Business as written by Keith Maddox, Pastor of Prairie Lea Baptist Church, and was approved without question or dissent.

Ray Still, Pastor of Oakwood Church, welcomed everyone, read Scripture from I Corinthians 15:58 and opened with prayer.

Congregational singing was led by the Oakwood Worship Team.

Dr. Robby Partain, Executive Director of the Association, presented his annual report. His written report is found on pages 10 and 11 of the 2024 Annual Book of Reports. He focused on three areas: BBA budget challenges, BBA church planting work and the Intern Partnership Plan. His oral report is attached as an addendum to these minutes.

Dr. J. K. Minton, Church Health Consultant for the Association, presented his annual report. His written report is found on page 12 of the 2024 Book of Reports. He also introduced Kevin Cornelius, Pastor of FBC Kyle and Matt Mletzko, Pastor of Solid Rock Church, San Marcos for their testimonies of how the Church Health ministry of BBA has assisted them in their ministry.

Dustin Wooten, Church Planting Consultant for the Association, presented his annual report. His written report is found on page 13 of the 2024 Book of Reports. BBA currently has 4 planters going through the church plant process.

The Administrative Team Report was presented by Paul Brand, Chair and Pastor of Bulverde Baptist Church. His report contained the following:

- The Year-to-Date Financial Report of the Association ending on September 30, 2024, is found on page 16 of the 2024 Book of Reports. Motion was made to accept the financial report as presented. There were no questions, and the report was approved without dissent.

Executive Director's Oral Report

First of all, I want to express appreciation to Pastor Ray Still and Oakwood Church for hosting and feeding us today. Thank you, Ray and team!

My written annual report to the association is contained in your Book of Reports. In my oral report today, I want to focus on three areas: Our budget challenges, our church planting work and the Intern Partnership Plan.

Budget Challenges

It's no secret that we've had our financial issues this year. We encountered a persistent budget deficit throughout the first half of 2024. We've addressed this in three ways. First, the staff and I have curtailed discretionary spending as much as possible without losing focus on our mission of assisting churches. Second, the Administrative Team, the moderator and I have communicated the situation to lead pastors in BBA. The response to that has been amazing! Churches have contributed generously above and beyond their regular contributions such that we are now running a modest budget surplus for the year.

Thirdly, the 2025 budget that will be submitted for your approval later in this meeting reflects significant reductions in spending, particularly in the personnel area. These reductions, though unpleasant, are necessary to get our operating costs more in line with the recurring contributions of BBA churches.

I'll admit that the budget situation was discouraging to me earlier in the year. However, you have encouraged me, certainly by your willingness to give additional resources to support the association's ministry, but even more so by your personal support, your friendship and your words of encouragement. Many of you have expressed to me the value you see in being part of Bluebonnet Baptist Association, that what we have is unique among associations and is meaningful to you in your ministry. I've found that to be very encouraging.

So, the bottom line on our budget is that we're still working the problem so we can live within our means while continuing to assist churches and church leaders in ways that make a difference.

Church Planting

Dustin will have more to say about church planting in his report, but what I want to do is remind you how important it is to the association and why we continue to place such an emphasis on it. At the present time, 35% of the active member churches in BBA are churches that were planted or are being planted through our process over the last 25 years. Those churches vary greatly in size, but collectively they account for 24% of our budget receipts from churches. Those churches also account for a majority of the baptisms in our association.

I've been involved in church planting for about 30 years now, and here's what I can tell you for sure: Church planting is messy, it's expensive, it's hard and unpredictable, and it's absolutely crucial to the future vitality and Great Commission impact of this association. So we're going to keep doing it. In fat years and lean years, we're going to keep doing it because it's the best thing we can do together to advance the kingdom of Christ in our region.

By the way, our planting process allows any church of any size and level of resources to participate in starting new churches. If you and your church want to get in the game, I know Dustin will be glad to talk with you.

The Intern Partnership Plan

We piloted the Intern Partnership Plan in 2022 and started it in earnest in 2023, so this year is our second full year of this ministry. The purpose of the Intern Partnership Plan is to create more "on ramps" for emerging ministry leaders. The association partners with supervising churches to fill, administer and fund part-time intern positions so that the intern gets hands-on, mentored experience in local church ministry for a defined period of time. The goal is that at the end of the internship the intern is better equipped for ministry leadership and is ready to take the next step in following God's call, whatever that step may be.

To date we've had twelve of these intern partnerships, including one that just got underway this month. I'm happy to report that two of our former interns are now lead pastors in BBA church plants; one is now lead pastor of an established church outside of BBA; and one is now a full-time associate pastor at a BBA church. That's exciting to me.

If you have a heart for developing other ministry leaders, let's talk about how the association can assist through the Intern Partnership Plan.

To close, I want to say thank you for allowing me to serve as your Executive Director. Susan and I are now in our 17th year with BBA and our 15th in my present capacity. You bless us

Frequently Asked Questions about BBA and the Budget

1. How is the association's budget formed? BBA has an annual budget that reflects our mission of assisting churches. We budget on the calendar year. Around early August of each year, the Executive Director prepares a budget draft using current-year receipts to forecast the next year's receipts. The staff reviews all personnel, ministry, and administrative expenses and develops budget estimates for the next year based on projected receipts and ministry plans. The Executive Director then meets with the BBA Administrative Team to review the budget proposal and to make changes as needed. Once the Administrative Team approves, the budget is sent to all member churches in advance of the BBA annual meeting in October. The messengers at the annual meeting must give final approval.

2. How is the budget funded? The budget is funded primarily by contributions from BBA member churches. There is no set amount for church contributions. Most churches give a percentage of their undesignated tithes and offerings each month. Some churches give a set dollar amount each month or quarter. In addition to the contributing churches, there are some generous individuals who also contribute to the budget of the association. The bottom line is that BBA is a cooperative ministry. The association is funded primarily by the churches for the purpose of *assisting churches*.

3. *How is the budget structured?* An established church typically has 50 – 60% of its budget in the personnel category. The rest of the church budget is taken up with facilities, ministry, and administrative expenses. The BBA budget is structured differently because BBA is not a church. Similar to previous budgets, the 2024 budget proposal has 78% of funds in the personnel category, which includes salaries, housing allowances, employment taxes, medical and other insurance, retirement account contributions, and reimbursable expenses for our employees. The rest of the budget is split between ministry and administrative expenses.

4. Why is BBA's budget structure so much different than a church's? Remembering that our mission is assisting churches, BBA does not usurp the primary place of the local church in ministering to the community. We do not operate large ongoing ministries as a church does (worship services, Sunday School, student ministry, music ministry, recreation programs, benevolence, outreach events, etc.). We also have low facilities costs. We exist to assist churches; the primary way we do that is through *staff time and expertise*. Our budget is structured to provide services to churches through associational staff and consultants. The specific ministries we budget for are also church assisting in nature: church planting, partnerships with local churches, and equipping church leaders.

5. Are all the association's ministries paid for through the budget? No, and this is another reason that our budget is weighted toward personnel. The association maintains designated accounts that allow us to go beyond our budget in assisting churches. These designated accounts are funded from past budget surpluses plus designated gifts from churches and individuals. These funds allow us to do more for churches in the areas of church planting, equipping and caring for ministry leaders, conferences and retreats, and partnering with churches in various ministries and missions endeavors. In addition, we have a Ministry and Maintenance Reserve designated account that ensures the association's ministry will continue uninterrupted in the case of a large, unforeseen event (such as a wide-scale weather event that disrupts receipts from churches, a large facilities expense like replacing the HVAC system, etc.).

We strive to be good stewards of the Lord's resources that are entrusted to us. We are audited by an independent CPA and our financial reports are public information. The budget is actively managed each year to make sure spending is in line with actual receipts.
